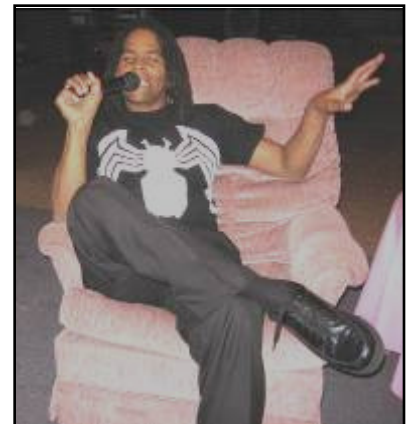

### ABOUT FOE CHARITY FOUNDATION

The Fraternal Order of Eagles is a non-profit organization, further classified by the IRS as a public charity, meaning, anyone can claim a tax-deductible contribution to the FOE Charity Foundation, whether the person is an Eagle member or not. This is fairly common knowledge. The actual letter of determination, dated January 24, 2006 and expiring May 31, 2009, is posted on the International website. What may not be common knowledge is the names of the eight funds that comprise the FOE Charity Foundation. They are Art Ehrmann Cancer Fund, D.D. Dunlap Kidney Fund, Muscular Dystrophy Fund, Max Baer Heart Fund, Judge Robert Hansen Diabetes Fund, Jimmy Durante Children's/Child Abuse Fund, Lew Reed Spinal Cord Injury Fund, and Circle of Life \$10 Patron Program. Each year at the beginning of his and her tenure, the Washington State Worthy and Madam Presidents choose and focus on a fund and a special project. Aeries and Auxiliaries in the State then help support the chosen fund and project with local fundraisers. Last year, for example, we raised funds for Jimmy Durante's Kids. This year the State of Washington Aeries and Auxiliaries are working on the Max Baer Heart Fund and the Special Olympics. Eagle's Whistle intends to publish progress reports as the information becomes available.
